Engineering Area

Participation in the double degree program

Tongji University, China

The following can participate in the selection to be admitted to the double degree:

- students **already selected for the Double Degree program in the academic year 2024/25** for the possible assignment of the financial contribution;
- students who are **enrolled in the third and fourth year of the course in the academic year 2025/26**, who can participate in admission to the double degree program and in the possible assignment of the financial contribution if they formally commit to:
 - make the required changes to the study plan in the academic year 2026/27, preparatory to attending the fifth year of the course at Tongji University;
 - start the mobility for the achievement of the double degree at Tongji University in the academic year 2027/28.

Medicine and Surgery Area

The following can apply:

- Students regularly enrolled in the course for the academic year 2025/26:
 - to the I, II, III, IV, V year of the single-cycle master's degree Course in Medicine and Surgery LM41 (Golgi Course and Harvey Course). **Students enrolled in the Degree Course in Medicine and Surgery must have passed the preparatory exams required by the Degree Course Schedule for the year in which the application is submitted**



- to the first and second year of the Degree Course in Nursing, Dietetics, Exercise Science, Physiotherapy, Neuro and Psychomotor Therapy of the Developmental Age, Occupational Therapy, Biomedical Laboratory Techniques, Medical Radiology, Imaging and Radiotherapy Techniques
- to the I, II, III, IV and V year of the single-cycle master's degree course in Dentistry and Dental Prosthetics
- in the first year of the master's degree Course in Sports Sciences and Techniques and Science and Techniques of Preventive and Adapted Physical Activities
- students enrolled for the academic year 2025/26 in Specialisation Schools and PhD courses related to the Faculty
- students enrolled in the sixth year in 2025/26 of the single-cycle master's degree Course in Medicine and Surgery LM41 (Golgi Course and Harvey Course) and all those who are repeating or out of course. **The Commission reserves the right to evaluate individual requests and related problems.**

Clarifications:

- the Commission of the Medicine and Surgery Area is made up of the Coordinator for International Mobility of the Area, as President, by Professors of the Medicine and Surgery Degree Course (Golgi and Harvey) and by a representative for each of the other Degree Courses pertaining to the area;
- in the preparation of the educational program to be carried out abroad, it is necessary to respect **the prerequisites of the exams provided for in the Italian system** and verify the "core" of the program of the chosen subject, which must be in line with the Italian one. In particular:
 - as a rule, **it will not be possible to anticipate exams for subsequent years**, except for a careful evaluation of the individual case and of the regularity and rationality and completeness of the program presented, considering the covalence of credits and the educational value;
 - it is preferable to include **integrated courses in the Learning Agreement** and not modules of courses. However, given the diversity of the educational offer of the various partner universities, the study plans will be carefully evaluated on a case-by-case basis, and, if the need arises to include only modules of an integrated course, it will be possible to carry out the remaining parts of the course itself once back at the University of Pavia;
 - study plans that provide for the **recovery of debts from previous years** in an inappropriate and incongruous way and not included in a curricular organic project will not be accepted;
 - given the above indications, with regard to the specific of students of the Degree Course in Medicine, **it is not recommended to apply for the Erasmus experience before the third and during the sixth year** (it is very difficult to identify compatible study plans at the affiliated universities, which do not provide for the advance or recovery of courses). The sixth year should be reserved for thesis preparation.

Drug Sciences Area

To carry out the thesis abroad, it is necessary to have acquired 150 credits by the deadline of the call.

Students who are regularly enrolled in the first year of the master's degree in African and Asian Studies for the academic year 2025/2026 can apply.

Candidates must have successfully passed at least 30 credits by the end of the first year of the master's degree in African and Asian Studies. The commission may admit students who do not yet meet the requirement at the deadline for the application with reservations.

University of Vaasa, Finland

Students who are regularly enrolled in the first year of the master's degree in World Politics and International Relations for the academic year 2025/2026 can apply.

Candidates must have successfully passed at least 20 credits by the end of the first year of the master's degree in World Politics and International Relations. The commission may admit students who do not yet meet the requirement at the deadline for the application with reservations.
