1. EDUCATIONAL OFFER

The University of Pavia, in collaboration with the University of Milan Bicocca and the University of Milan, is offering an inter-university degree course in Artificial Intelligence (L-31), taught in English, for the 2026/2027 academic year.

The degree programme is limited access, as per the following quotas:

*In absence of valid applications, vacant places in the Marco Polo quotas will be assigned to the quota reserved for NON-EU students' residing outside Italy. Any remaining places in the latter quota will then be allocated to EU and non-EU students legally residing in Italy.

2. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To be admitted to the Artificial Intelligence Degree Course, the following conditions must be met:

- Possess of one of the following titles:
 - Italian upper secondary school diploma;
 - valid academic qualification obtained outside Italy; a preliminary administrative verification of the academic qualification must be requested before the enrollment following the instructions reported in [paragraphs 3.4](#) and [4.2](#) (if the qualification has not yet been obtained, candidates must upload the most recent available transcript of records or a declaration of the school confirming the enrollment in the final schooling year and including the expected graduation date).
- To have taken the test requested for the quota to which they belong:
 - Quota for EU and non-EU students regularly residing in Italy
 - **CEnT-S test** certificate; this test must have been taken at any Italian university from November 2025 onwards, either in the CEnT@UNI (on premises) or CEnT@CASA (online) format. The test must be taken by the deadline of the call for application.
 - OR
 - **CISIA ENGLISH TOLC-I** certificate; this test must have been taken at any Italian university from January 1st, 2025, either in the TOLC@UNI (on premises) or TOLC@CASA (online) format. This test was discontinued in November 2025 and is no longer available.

- Quota for non-EU students residing outside Italy – SAT test.

3. HOW TO APPLY [EU students or NON-EU students legally residing in Italy]

The application and enrollment procedure consist of the following steps:

STEP 1 Registration to the call and application for admission.

STEP 2 Retrieval of the CEnT-S and English TOLC-I results and verification of the requirements to compete for a place.

STEP 3 Placement on the final merit ranking list and eligibility for admission.

STEP 4 Pre-enrolment and payment of the 1st installment of university fees by the deadlines specified in the following paragraphs.

RECONSIDERATION FOR VACANT PLACES - candidates who were not in positions eligible for enrollment can request to be reconsidered for vacant places.

3.1 STEP 1 - REGISTRATION TO THE CALL AND APPLICATION FOR ADMISSION

Candidates must register for the competition following the instructions provided below and within the deadline indicated in [paragraph 3.6](#):

- ✓ **REGISTER TO OBTAIN LOGIN CREDENTIALS:** connect to the website <https://studentonline.unipv.it/esse3/Home.do>, select REGISTER and complete all the required steps.
 - This step is not necessary if you already have the credentials to log in to Reserved Area of the University of Pavia website:
 - If you have lost/forgotten your credentials, you must request a new password following the instructions available here: <https://studentonline.unipv.it/Anagrafica/PasswordDimenticata.do>;
 - **Verify that your personal data (especially the Codice Fiscale - Italian tax code) provided during registration on the CISIA portal for TOLC or CEnT exams match exactly those entered on the University of Pavia website for the application for admission.** In case of discrepancies, and in particular in the Codice Fiscale (Italian tax code), test results cannot be retrieved and you will be excluded from the competition.
- ✓ **REGISTER FOR THE CALL** using the username and password obtained when registering. Go to the Student Area, click on the menu item Admissions > Admission Test and choose *Artificial Intelligence-1st year admission for EU and NON-EU students regularly residing in Italy*. Students must refer to the deadlines and indications reported in [paragraph 3.6](#).

Candidates who successfully complete the registration step will receive a confirmation email at the address provided during registration.
- ✓ **ONLY CANDIDATES HOLDING AN UPPER SECONDARY SCHOOL DIPLOMA NOT OBTAINED IN ITALY** during the mentioned registration must:
 - Attach the following documentation:
 - Original upper secondary school diploma (or authorized copy or replacement certificate) obtained after at least 12 schooling years. Documents must be translated into Italian and legalized by the Italian diplomatic authorities in the country where the diploma was obtained, or bear an "apostille" stamp from the local authorities for countries party to the Aja convention of 05/10/1961, or be accompanied by a Statement of Verification issued by CIMEA. In case the diploma is issued in English, Spanish or French, translations are not required. If legalization is not available at the time of the application it will be possible to comply with this requirement later within the deadlines indicated herein.
 - Declaration of Value issued by the Italian diplomatic authority or CIMEA Statement of Comparability (it can be requested on this page <https://cimea-diplome.it/>), if available. Alternatively, candidates holding a qualification awarded by countries party to the Lisbon Convention can submit the Statement of Correspondence that can be downloaded from the ARDI database (<https://ardi.cimea.it/en>). If the Declaration of Value or the Statement of Comparability or the Statement of Correspondence were not available at the time of the application, it will be possible to comply with this requirement later within the deadlines indicated herein.
 - Certificate of passing the university entrance test, if mandatory in the country where the diploma was obtained.
 - Candidates who are eligible for enrollment will be assigned an *Evaluation fee for foreign qualification* (35 €) requested to evaluate the suitability of the school diploma for the access to the program.

Applications are considered valid only if they include all the documentation described above; applications with incomplete documentation will not be accepted

Candidates with a study title not obtained in Italy can send a support request to admission@unipv.it , further information on qualifications can be found on [this page](#).

Holders of a residence permit, or a receipt of application or renewal, must attach a scan of the documentation (relative to the residence permit). If the permit was requested or obtained for study purposes, it is also necessary to attach a valid enrollment certificate from the previous University.

3.2. STEP 2 - RETRIVAL OF THE ENGLISH TOLC-I OR CEnT-S TEST RESULTS

The procedure automatically retrieves English TOLC-I or CEnT-S results from CISIA, verifying the following requirements:

- CEnT-S:
 - The CEnT-S test has been taken between November 2025 and the deadline of the call for application for the BSc Program in Artificial Intelligence.
 - The score used to compete for a placement in the ranking list is the normalized overall score for sections *Mathematics* and *Reasoning on texts and data*.
 - The aforementioned normalized score is greater than or equal to 20.
- English TOLC-I:
 - The English TOLC-I test has been taken from January 1st, 2025 onwards.
 - The total score used to compete for a placement in the ranking list is greater than or equal to 21/50.

In the event that the applicant has taken multiple CEnT-S and/or English TOLC-I tests, the best result available at the closure of the application window will be retrieved.

3.3. STEP 3 - RANKING LIST

The final ranking will be published on the [dedicated webpage](#) according to the deadlines indicated in [paragraph 3.6](#).

Candidates who have achieved a test score consistent with the requirements specified in [paragraph 3.2](#) are eligible to admission, within the limit of available places, and ranked in descending order of the obtained scores that have been converted by the Committee using a formula that correlates CEnT results with TOLC results. In case of equal scores (tie), the candidate with the highest score in the Mathematics section will be selected; in case of an equal score in the Mathematics section, the priority will be given to the candidate who applied first in chronological order.

No personal communications concerning the eligibility for admission will be sent.

Admitted candidates who are studying in a non-Italian school and that are still waiting for the final school diploma must graduate and send the diploma to the Admission Office within September 30, 2026.

3.4. STEP 4 - ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

Pre-enrollment and the payment of the first installment of the tuition fee must be completed online according to the deadlines stated in [paragraph 3.6](#) (Intakes) and following the instructions provided at page <https://en.unipv.it/en/education/bachelors-and-masters-degree-programs/how-apply/how-apply-bachelors-or-single-cycle-masters-degree-programs>.

Candidates with EU citizenship anywhere residing or non-EU citizenship regularly residing in Italy holding a non-Italian secondary school diploma who are eligible for enrollment must pay a 35 € *Evaluation fee for foreign qualification*, which can be found in their reserved area. The application fee can be found in the Student Area > Menu > Admissions > Payments. The payment of the application fee is mandatory for the enrollment request to be considered valid. Candidates who do not complete the payment within the enrollment deadline will be deemed to have withdrawn their application and will be excluded from the ranking.

- Transfer from another degree course within the University of Pavia
Admitted candidate that are already enrolled in another degree course at the University of Pavia must follow the instructions provided at this link <https://en.unipv.it/en/education/bachelors-and-masters-degree-programs/attend-your-program/degree-course-change> by the assigned deadlines.

From this point onward, candidates are not permitted to take exams in their previous degree program. Exams for the new program may only be taken after receiving the official resolution regarding the recognition of their prior academic career.

➤ Transfer from another University

Admitted candidates transferring from another university must enroll by the assigned deadline following the described procedures, selecting 'Incoming Transfer' (trasferimento in ingresso) and paying the enrollment fee. An additional 16 € virtual revenue stamp for the incoming transfer will be added.

Students who achieved a normalized score lower than 12 in the *Mathematics* section of the CEnT-S test or a score lower than 9/20 in *Mathematics* section of the English TOLC-I (at the University or at home) will be assigned an additional exam to pass during their first year (Obbligo Formativo Aggiuntivo, O.F.A.). 3.5. RECONSIDERATION FOR VACANT PLACES: APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Candidates who were not in positions eligible for enrollment can request to be reconsidered for vacant places. The request must be sent within the deadlines indicated in [paragraph 3.6](#) following these steps:

- log in to your student portal;
- select the menu item Admissions > Admission Test;
- access the page concerning the *Artificial Intelligence – 1st year admission for EU and non-EU students regularly residing in Italy*;
- click on *Presenta Domanda*;
- confirm the choice in the final page of the process.

No fee is due for the reconsideration request.

Places remaining vacant after the enrollment step (Step 4) will be reassigned, following the ranking order, to candidates who have submitted a reconsideration request. Candidates must check their student portal: if the status ADMITTED appears on the section *Concorso*, they are eligible to enroll following the procedures described in [paragraph 3.4](#) by the deadline shown next to the status. **No personal communications will be sent.**

3.6. INTAKES

3.6.1. First intake – from June 9, at 9.00 am, to June 25, 2026, at 11.59 pm

Candidates who want to compete for a place during the first intake must register for the competition called *<Artificial Intelligence – 1st year admission for EU and non-EU students regularly residing in Italy >* between **June 9, 2026, at 9.00 am, Italian time, and June 25, 2026, at 11.59 pm** (please refer to the instructions in [paragraph 3.1](#)).

In this first intake, CEnT-S and TOLC test results will be retrieved no earlier than June 30 and the ranking list will be published on July 13, 2026. Candidates in eligible position will be able to enroll **between July 13 at 10.00 am (Italian time) and July 23, 2026, at 11.59 pm** following the procedure described in [paragraph 3.4](#).

Candidates enrolling with a pending Italian secondary school diploma (i.e. candidates who are studying in the last school year awaiting graduation) must log in their reserved area by July 31, 2026, to complete and update all details related to their educational qualification once this has been obtained. Enrolled students who have not completed the details of their diploma by September 15, 2026, will be blocked from all academic activities and, on September 30, 2026, their academic career will be terminated due to administrative irregularity.

Candidates who have not been admitted for enrollment will be allowed to submit the request for reconsideration for vacant places between **July 13 at 10.00 am (Italian time) and July 20 at 12.00 pm**.

Reassignments of places remaining vacant due to withdrawal, transfer to other courses, or admission to course years beyond the first will take place from July 24 and August 20, 2026, until full capacity is reached.

Candidates who do not submit a reconsideration request for vacant places by July 20 at 12.00 pm will be deemed to have withdrawn their application and will be excluded from the ranking.

3.6.2. Second intake – from October 5, at 9.00 am, to October 22, 2026, at 11.59 pm

Candidates who want to compete for a place during this intake must register for the competition called <Artificial Intelligence – 1st year admission for EU and non-EU students regularly residing in Italy > between **October 5, 2026, at 9.00 am, Italian time, and October 22, 2026, at 11.59 pm** (please refer to the instructions in [paragraph 3.1](#)).

In this intake, CE nT-S and TOLC test results will be retrieved no earlier than October 30 and the ranking list will be published on November 10, 2026. Candidates in eligible position will be able to enroll **between November 10 at 10.00 am (Italian time) and November 16, 2026, at 11.59 pm** following the procedure described in [paragraph 3.4](#).

Candidates who have not been admitted for enrollment will be allowed to submit the request for reconsideration for vacant places between **November 10 at 10.00 am (Italian time) and November 13 at 12.00 pm**.

Reassignments of places remaining vacant due to withdrawal, transfer to other courses, or admission to course years beyond the first will take place from November 17 and November 30, 2026, until full capacity is reached.

Candidates who do not submit a reconsideration request for vacant places by November 13 at 12.00 pm will be deemed to have withdrawn their application and will be excluded from the ranking.

The competent Teaching Board reserves the right to decide whether to activate an additional call for applications should places remain available after processing all positions in the ranking mentioned in [paragraph 3.3](#). Relevant information will be published on the [webpage of the program](#).

4. HOW TO APPLY [NON-EU STUDENTS RESIDING OUTSIDE ITALY]

Non-EU students residing outside Italy who are eligible for enrollment must apply for a visa for study purposes by registering through the [University](#) portal and, after the University has validated the application, must contact the Italian Diplomatic Authority in their home country to complete the procedure.

4.1. ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

To compete for places, applicants must have taken a **SAT test** with an total score greater than or equal to 979/1600. The test must have been taken by the deadline of the intake.

4.2. HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR APPLICATION

Candidates can submit their application **from April 28 at 12.00 am (Italian time) to May 18, 2026, at 11.59 pm** following these steps:

- ✓ REGISTER at the link <https://apply.unipv.eu/>
- ✓ ATTACH:
 - SAT scoresheet certificate in pdf format. Candidates will also have to log in their reserved area on the College Board portal, select the function “Send Scores” and find the University of Pavia (Code 62940) among the available institutions. Using this procedure, it will be possible to request that the digital copy of the SAT scoresheet is officially sent to the Admission Office of the University of Pavia.
 - Documents regarding the final school diploma (final diploma or replacement certificate or authorized copy; transcript of records; certificate of the university entrance test, if mandatory in the country where the qualification was obtained). Candidates can submit the declaration of value or CIMEA Statement of Comparability or ARDI Statement of Correspondence, if available.

The application will be considered valid only if the required documents have been submitted by May 18 at 11.59 PM, Italian time, otherwise it will not be considered valid.

- ✓ PAY the *application fee* of 35 € (non-refundable). The payment must be carried out no later than May 18, the application portal allows the submission of the applications only after the *application fee* has been fully processed. Applications that have not been properly submitted will not be considered.

4.3. RANKING LIST AND ENROLLMENT

The ranking list will be published on **May 28, 2026**, on the [dedicated webpage](#). Candidates who possess the requirements reported in [paragraph 4.1](#) are eligible to admission, within the limit of available places, and ranked according to their SAT score in descending order. In case of equal scores (tie), the candidate with the highest score in the Mathematics section will be selected; in case of an equal score in the Mathematics section, the priority will be given to the candidate who applied first in chronological order.

Admitted candidates can enroll **from May 28 from 11.00 am Italian time until June 9, 2026, at 11.59 pm**, following the instructions published on page <https://en.unipv.it/en/education/bachelors-and-masters-degree-programs/how-apply/how-apply-bachelors-or-single-cycle-masters-degree-programs>. The evaluation of the suitability of educational qualifications for the access to university will be carried out by the Admission Office. To confirm the eligibility for enrollment, a positive evaluation is necessary. For information on the criteria applied for the evaluation please consult the [dedicated webpage](#).

Places that are vacant after June 9, 2026 will be assigned to the candidates in the ranking list according to their placement based on the SAT score. The list will be scrolled until all available places are assigned. List movements will end on August 28, 2026.

Students who obtained a score lower than 510/800 in the Mathematics section of the SAT exam will be assigned with an extra exam to pass during their first year (*Obbligo Formativo Aggiuntivo, O.F.A.*). Details about the O.F.A. credits are available at this link <https://bai.unipv.it/home-eng/enrolled-students/>.

Admitted candidates who are studying in a non-Italian school and that are still waiting for the final school diploma must graduate and send the diploma to the Admission Office within September 30, 2026.

Candidates with a non-Italian study title can send a support request to admission@unipv.it.

5. EVALUATION OF PREVIOUS ACADEMIC CAREER - PRE-EVALUATION REQUEST

Candidates with a prior academic career may apply for admission to years beyond the first by submitting a request of evaluation of previous academic career. In case of uncertainty regarding eligibility for admission to years beyond the first, it is recommended to also follow the placement procedures established for first-year entry students.

The pre-evaluation request must be submitted from **August 24 to 28, 2026**.

Information notice pursuant to art. 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 on the protection of personal data

Pursuant to Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (hereinafter GDPR), the data provided by applicants will be processed by the University of Pavia, in its capacity as Data Controller, in order to pursue its institutional ends and carry out the University's public interest tasks, pursuant to art. 6 letter e) of the GDPR. In particular, the data will be processed to allow the provision of the specific services requested by users and relating to the completion of selection procedures for admission to study courses, as described in the competitive test notice, and the fulfilment of legal requirements.

Data are collected in compliance with the principles of lawfulness, correctness, relevance, completeness and non-excess, in relation to the purposes for which they are processed. Data processing is based on respect for the general principles of lawfulness, correctness, transparency, adequacy, relevance, and necessity, using appropriate technical and organizational measures to protect the privacy and the rights of data subjects.

Processing is carried out, as a general rule, through the aid of computer-based and online tools to store and manage the collected data, in some phases paper-based media may be used, in all cases in such a way as to guarantee data security and protect the confidentiality of the data subject.

Failure to consent to the provision of personal data will result in the applicant being excluded from the admission test/excluded from the selection procedure.

Users' personal data may become known and processed, in compliance with current legislation on the subject, by personnel expressly in charge of data processing.

The data provided by applicants will be kept by the University of Pavia only for the time strictly necessary to pursue the above ends and, in any case, in compliance with legislation on the conservation of administrative documentation.

Applicants shall enjoy the rights set forth in articles 15-18 of the aforementioned Regulation, including: access to personal data, their rectification, updating, integration, deletion, etc. as well as objection to the use of data other than the institutional ends mentioned above. Complaints should be submitted to the Data Controller and/or Data Protection Officer (DPO).
